



# 2024 Rose Bowl Competitions

## GENERAL ROSE BOWL RULES

- ♪ Top competitors in each discipline will be chosen by the adjudicator for that discipline. Performance levels earned will be the primary consideration, but other factors may be used in the final determination.
- ♪ Competitors must have earned a Gold performance rating as a minimum to be considered.
- ♪ Competitors must meet the minimum requirements for 'Outstanding Performer Scholarships' as outlined in the BKMf Rules & Regulations found here - <https://barriemusicfestival.com/barrie-kiwanis-music-festival/rules-regulations>, points 45, 46 & 47.
- ♪ Music must be memorized by competitors in Piano, Classical Voice, Musical Theatre and Guitar categories. Strings competitors must follow the OMFA memorization requirements for their category. Music may be used by competitors in Woodwinds and Brass categories without penalty.
- ♪ Accompaniment is required for all pieces, unless specifically composed as a solo (unaccompanied) piece. Accompaniment must also follow OMFA rules for competitor's discipline with respect to type/regulations.
- ♪ Suitable stage attire and deportment will provide part of the basis for assessment. Concert dress is expected for both competitors and accompanists.
- ♪ All repertoire performed in the Rose Bowl competition must have been performed during the current Festival. Competitors may choose to perform two selections of a contrasting nature rather than one longer selection. Competitors may wish to consult the Festival Office before choosing their repertoire.

**Joyce Langford Memorial  
Senior Rose Bowl**

- ♪ Competitors will be comprised of the top performer from Level 9, 10 or Diploma in each of Piano, Classical Voice, Woodwinds, Brass, Strings, Guitar and Musical Theatre
- ♪ There must be at least two competitors for the Senior Rose Bowl competition to be held.
- ♪ Performance time limit per competitor: 15 minutes maximum. Competitors exceeding this time limit will be ineligible to win the Senior Rose Bowl.
- ♪ All repertoire performed in the Senior Rose Bowl must be at Level 9, 10 or Diploma, with the exception of Musical Theatre.
- ♪ The Senior Rose Bowl winner will be decided by a panel of judges. Only the winner will be announced. There will be no written or verbal adjudication of the performances.
- ♪ The winner of the Joyce Langford Memorial Senior Rose Bowl is required to perform at the Spirit of Music Showcase Concert on Saturday May 11<sup>th</sup> (concert starts at 6:30pm) in order to receive their prize money.
- ♪ The Runners-Up for the Senior Rosebowl will receive a \$150 prize to acknowledge their excellence in their discipline.

**Bruce Owen Memorial  
Junior Rose Bowl**

- ♪ Competitors will be comprised of the top performer from Level 7 or 8 in each of Piano, Classical Voice, Woodwinds, Brass, Strings, Guitar and Musical Theatre
- ♪ There must be at least two competitors for the Junior Rose Bowl competition to be held.
- ♪ Performance time limit per competitor: 10 minutes maximum. Competitors exceeding this time limit will be ineligible to win the Junior Rose Bowl.
- ♪ All repertoire performed in the Junior Rose Bowl must be at Level 7 or 8, with the exception of Musical Theatre.
- ♪ The Junior Rose Bowl winner will be decided by a panel of judges. Only the winner will be announced. There will be no written or verbal adjudication of the performances.
- ♪ The winner of the Bruce Owen Memorial Junior Rose Bowl is required to perform at the Spirit of Music Showcase Concert on Saturday May 11<sup>th</sup> (concert starts at 6:30pm) in order to receive their prize money.
- ♪ The Runners-Up for the Junior Rosebowl will receive a \$100 prize to acknowledge their excellence in their discipline.
